## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### 1. PARTICIPATION:

- a. **NO REGISTRATION FEES** is required to be paid for the V.S. Sundaram Memorial Research Paper Competition.
- b. An article can be authored by maximum of two students.
- c. Entries must be in English only.
- d. Participation is restricted to students enrolled in undergraduate courses in Law, Accountancy, Commerce and Taxation.
- e. Participants must also submit a short bio- data mentioning their full name, college name, contact number, email and postal address.

#### 2. <u>PRESENTATION:</u>

- a. The research article must comprise of not less than 7500 words and not more 10000 words including footnotes.
- b. The following content specifications shall be strictly adhered to:
  - i. The research article should be typed on A4 size paper.
  - ii. Body Font and Size: Times New Roman, 12.
  - iii. Line Spacing: Double Space.
  - iv. Footnotes Font and Size: Times New Roman, 10.
  - v. Line Spacing: 1.0.
  - vi. Alignment (Body & Footnotes): Justified.
  - vii. Margin: 1 inch on all 4 sides.
  - viii. Citation Method: The Bluebook, A Uniform System of Citation, Harvard Law Review, 20th edition.
- c. A bibliography, mentioning all the articles, books, references, websites etc. referred to, should be made at the end.
- d. Participants must email a copy of their entry as a Read-Only MS-Word document to <u>krramamani11@gmail.com</u> and info@saprlaw.com on or before 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2021 by 23:59 hours.
- e. The subject of the mail shall be "Entries for VSS Research Paper".

f. Copyrights of all authors are respected but Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University will not be responsible for any infringement of the same.

- a. Each Research article will be marked on a total of 100 marks.
